To provide a support network for you while you are in school.

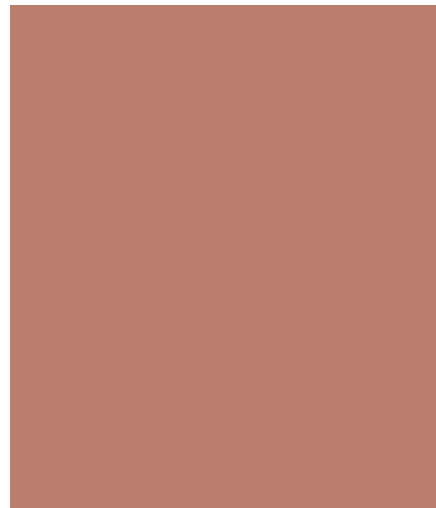
This could include:

To provide buddies or mentors for Service children needing a little extra help in school or who just need a friend to talk to.

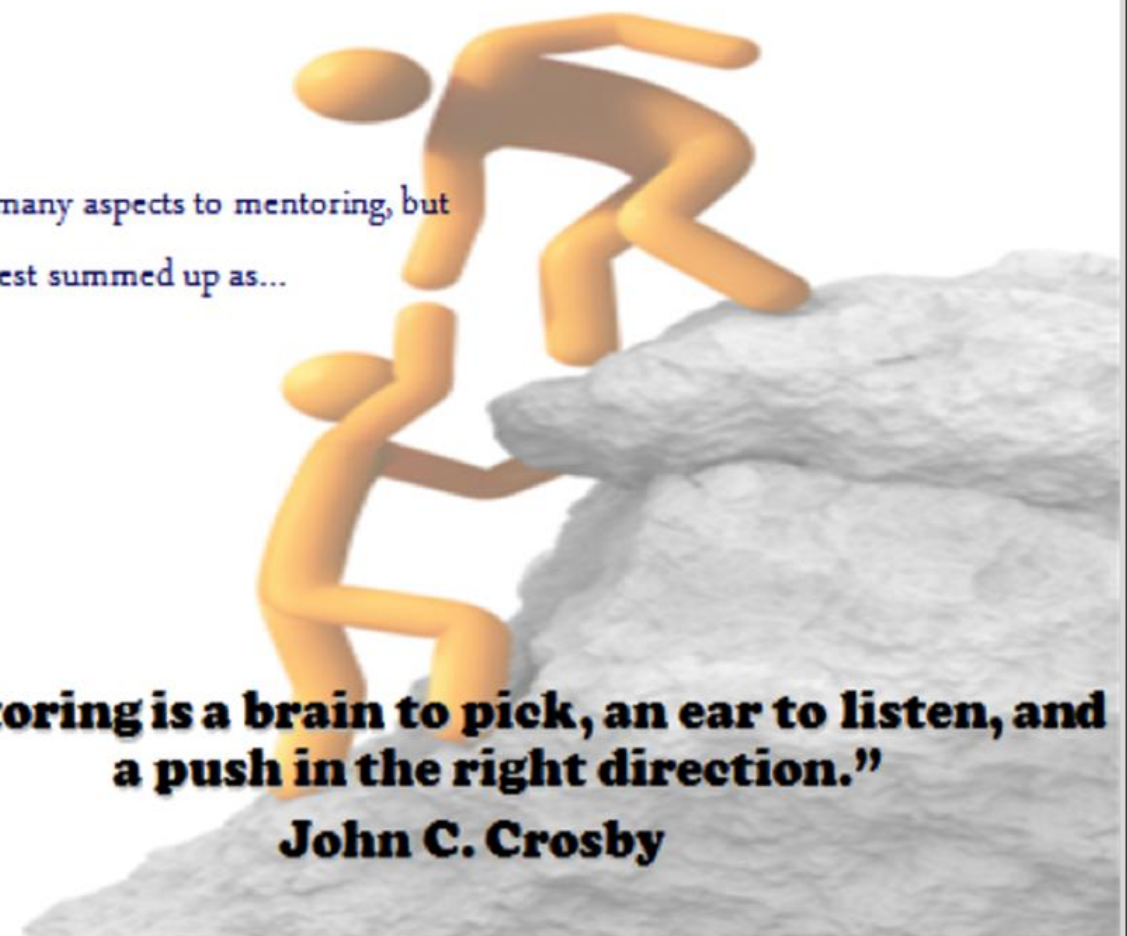


WHAT IS MENTORING?

“Mentoring is a brain to pick, an ear to listen, and a push in the right direction.”

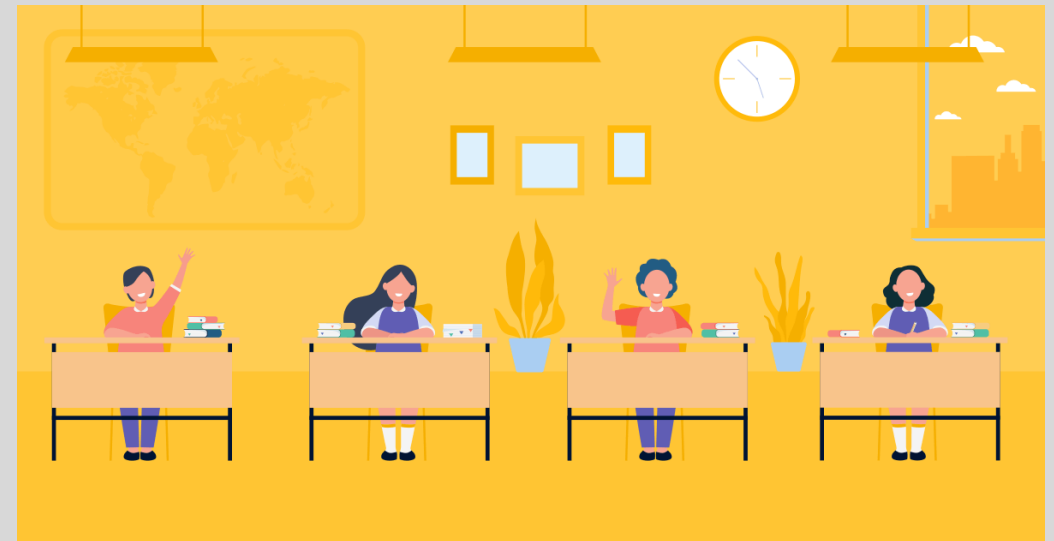
