Shortly after the practice an engineer attended and fixed the technical issues; our Site Manager now completes weekly tests of the system to minimise the chance of the issue reoccurring.

We will be carrying out another full lockdown practice next week on Tuesday 7th May. Students will be aware that this is a practice.

Summer Examinations - message from Miss Nightingale, Vice Principal

Students in Year 10 (for RPE), Year 11, Year 12 and Year 13 who are sitting any public exams this summer have received their personal timetable at the start of this week. 
