



Use you own knowledge to explain the source...


Eg: "From my own knowledge...."

Explain why we might not fully trust the source. *The source is not 100% useful because it has limitations. For example...*


Explain agreement/usefulness I would agree because I know that ... It is useful because ... For example ...

DESCRIBE [5]



Simple description!

Eg: Five clear specific details or two/3 expanded in more detail.


5 sentences could be enough!

Explain Questions

Why was...? Explainhow...?

EXPLAINIT



Explain one reason:

Eg: One reason was,.... This was significant because... (go into a lot of detail that helps answer the question) Add a final summative sentence that links back to the question.

Explain a second reason :

Eg: Furthermore, a second reason was... This was important because...

(go into a lot of detail that helps answer the question) Add a final summative sentence that links back to the question.
