

# UNIFORM

*School uniform improves discipline, raises standards and reduces peer pressure and bullying.*

- **School Sweatshirt** - dark green, with embroidered badge in house colours
- **School Polo-shirt** - white with embroidered school badge in house colours

The polo-shirt should never be hanging out so that it shows below the sweatshirt.  
The collar should be showing, not tucked away.

- **Plain black trousers**  
Full length, smart, not tight. (No stretchy material).  
No jeans, nor trousers resembling jeans (i.e. no studs, stitching, zips or pockets like jeans)
- **Plain black skirt**  
Smart, not tight. (No stretchy material).  
Pleated or straight,  
No more than three inches above or below the knee.
- **Plain white or black socks**
- **Plain black or natural tights**
- **Plain black or dark brown shoes with a low, sensible heel.**  
No trainers
- **Accessories**  
No badges (apart from school badges) pendants, belts, flowers or bows  
No noticeably dyed or brightly coloured hair  
Scarves and hats may only be worn outside and must be taken off immediately once indoors.

## MAKE-UP & JEWELLERY

### KS3 (years 7, 8 and 9)

No make-up or nail varnish  
One ring; one small stud ear-ring in each ear  
No other jewellery or piercings

### KS4 (Years 10 and 11)

**Unobtrusive** make-up and jewellery  
Clear or soft pink nail varnish  
No facial piercings

## EQUIPMENT

Good organisation and having the basic equipment to complete work is very important.  
In tutor period and in every lesson, students must have at least:

- a pen
- a pencil
- a calculator
- their planner

## MOBILE TELEPHONES / MP3 PLAYERS / DIGITAL CAMERAS

**Not to be switched on or used on the school premises at all during school time.**

If seen or heard by staff, the item will be immediately confiscated and only an adult will be allowed to collect it from the reception area.

Inappropriate use of such devices may result in serious sanctions being taken.

Other items deemed a nuisance or safety risk will be confiscated and in some cases (e.g. laser pens) not returned.
