Dear Parents / Carers,

please find attached the revised guidelines booklet for September reopening. The changes are only very minor and are as follows:

- A note about staff potentially wearing visors when on duty in the corridors or at break and lunchtime (page 7)
- A note about parents not being able to bring forgotten items (e.g. lunch, PE kit etc) on to site. This is due to minimising the number of visitors to the site and staff being unable to touch any of these items (page 7)
- A note about students being seated by year group on the bus (page 8)
- The removal of social distancing requirements for fire drills in line with national advice (page 13)

This guidance is up to date as of 24th August 2020. Should we need to amend it, for example following a Government or Public Health England / National Institute for Health update, we will do this and will send it out, drawing attention to any changes made.

Furthermore, all of the measures in this booklet will be reviewed in October and any changes made will be communicated to parents. Please note that something not mentioned in the booklet is the fact that we are only able to have school photographs for students in Years 7 and 12 this year. For all other students, last year's photo will be used on the system. We apologise for any upset that this may cause.
