
# Student and Parent / Carer Surveys Autumn 2023









### **STUDENT SURVEY AUTUMN 2023**

1,210 Responses (1,047 responses in June 2023, 1,360 responses in November 2022)

For quite a few questions student opinion seems to be similar to the Summer 2023 survey however lower than at the corresponding point last year (for example 'I enjoy school', 'teachers help me do my best', 'my teachers give me work that challenges me'). However for some questions positive responses have increased since the Summer 2023 survey, returning to similar levels to Autumn 2022 (for example 'I feel safe when I am at school', 'My school provides me with information about my next steps').

There are some questions where positive responses have increased compared to both Autumn 2022 and Summer 2023. Indeed questions relating to there being an adult at school students can talk to and to behaviour being good are both at their most positive in the last three years.

Less positively the questions relating to looking after physical and emotional / mental health are both at their least positive in the past three years.

Where students were able to leave comments relating to certain questions these were overwhelmingly positive. Students rated teachers and the quality of teaching as the best thing about Hinchingbrooke (up from the third best thing in the Autumn 2022 survey and up from the 5<sup>th</sup> best thing in the Summer 2023 survey). Other frequently mentioned positives included the food, sport opportunities and PE, and the school site and facilities.

Of the 60% of students who said they would recommend the school to a friend the most frequently given reason related to the school being 'good'. Teachers and the school ethos were also cited often, as was the belief that it's the best school in the area. The most common reason given for not recommending the school related to rules being too strict.

Unfortunately barely any Year 13 students completed the survey. Based on previous years' surveys, the inclusion of more responses from Year 13 students would almost certainly have made the overall picture from student feedback even more positive than it is in these results.

Overall positive responses have increased in almost all categories suggesting all-round improvement in parental satisfaction. The most significant increase is in the question 'I keep myself informed about how my child is doing at school (eg through reading their reports, checking the Arbor App, attending parent/carer evenings where I can talk to my child's teachers)'. Although the wording of this question has changed, which may explain the increase in part, the almost 100% positive response suggests that the school is providing sufficient information about student progress and other aspects of school life and that parents and carers are engaging with this.

Other significant increases in positive responses relate to questions regarding the school making sure students are well behaved (up 9% compared to Autumn 2022 and up 11% compared to Summer 2023) and 'my child does well at this school' (up 9% compared to both survey points last year). In addition positive responses to the question around the school having high expectations have increased by 4% compared to Autumn 2022 and by 10% compared to Summer 2023; the difference is even more stark in comparison to 2021-2022 where positive responses are now 14% higher.

The only area to see a significant reduction in positive responses is the question on clubs and extra-curricular activities, which is down to 83% compared to 90% this time last year and 85% in Summer 2023. As a school we know that those extra-curricular opportunities are there so it may be a case of needing to promote these more to parents, carers and students.

A greater proportion of parents and carers would recommend the school compared to this time last year (up 7%). 81% of parents and carers agree that Hinchingbrooke is a good school, compared to 74% in Autumn 2022 and 77% in Summer 2023.

Where parents and carers were able to explain why they think Hinchingbrooke is or is not a good school, a significant number mentioned that their child was happy and making good progress. There were also many positive comments about staff. Negative comments centred mostly around the behaviour system and Arbor, the school not dealing well with individual students' needs and staff turnover / too many cover lessons. Overall positive comments far outnumbered negative ones (over two and a half times more positive than negative). Interestingly, while the number of negative comments was similar to those made in the Summer 2023 survey, there were considerably more positive comments made (approximately one hundred more than Summer 2023). This may suggest that although the school hasn't managed to change the opinion of those parents and carers who do not view the school as good, there has been a shift whereby more parents and carers have something positive to say about the school. Other feedback offered in the final question (Is there any other feedback you would like to give?) was broadly in line with the comments made for the 'Hinchingbrooke is a good school' comments.

# **Parent/Carer Survey**

- We are very pleased with the increase and range of positive comments, as well as the increase in positive responses. The Arbor app seems to have had a positive impact in terms of information sharing between home and school
- The responses remaining the same to the question 'When I have raised concerns with the school, the school has listened and responded well' is a concern. In the Summer survey we will have two questions on this area; one around whether parents and carers received a response within 48 hours as per school guidance and one around whether raising the issue led to a resolution, so as to ascertain where the lower level of positive responses is coming from. We will also reshare our Communications Policy to remind parents and carers of expectations
- As there were some comments around parents' evening remaining online, we will reshare our reasons for using this format in an upcoming weekly message
- We were concerned that the number of respondents to the parent and carer survey remains low (c.16%) so will offer a prize draw option in the next survey to see if this encourages a greater number of responses. We will also continue to use the 'you said, we did' logo in communications to demonstrate actions taken as a result of parent / carer feedback, demonstrating the important impact this feedback has

## **Student Survey**

- We are pleased with the high number of student respondents, making the data representative and therefore more insightful
- We are very pleased to see teaching and the quality of teaching being rated highest on the best thing about Hinchingbrooke, but want to discuss further the perception of a minority that the school is too strict this might be something for the new school council to address
- We need to consider more ways of promoting both physical and mental health across the school, both in lessons and as part of form time and assemblies
- It might be useful to hold form time discussions around some of the questions raised in the survey, to ensure students have had the opportunity to reflect on these areas and fully understand the questions being asked prior to completing the survey
- We will share feedback with students about the survey so they can see how their responses compared to the whole-school picture and what some of our next steps will be following their feedback
