Re: Summer Tutoring Programme 2025

We have a fantastic opportunity for our Year 10 students this summer. It involves some extra tuition over the holidays in preparation for success in Year 11. Over 130 students took part in the programme last year and the majority said it helped to boost their confidence, improve their grades and prepare them for the rigours of Year 11.

Online Tutoring in Core Subjects

- Students can sign up for a weeks' worth of tutoring (5 hours over 5 mornings) in one of the Core subjects (English Language, Maths, Biology, Chemistry or Physics).
- Students will receive this tutoring online from our partner tutoring company, Tutor Doctor Cambridge.
- Students will be in small groups of no more than 4 students (all from Hinchingbrooke)
- Students will receive an hour's worth of online tuition each morning between 10 and 11am for 5 mornings in a row (unless specified).
- Students cannot see each other but can hear the tutor and the tutor can see them completing work on the online platform.
- The tutor will cover topics identified by the school and the student as areas for development.
- · Students can sign up for as many weeks as they wish over the summer holidays
- · Students can only have tutoring in one subject per week.
- Students can sign up for multiple subjects by signing up for multiple weeks (so week 1 could be English, week 2 Maths etc)
- Students could do multiple weeks on one subject as the topics will be different week on week
- · The cost is £70 for each week, which is non-refundable.
- If your child is Free School Meals, we will charge a deposit of £30 per week which will be returned in September, if the student has attended all 5 sessions.

This is an amazing opportunity for the students and involves a relatively small investment of time for a potentially large gain.
