Top 10 Tips

1. **Deadlines** – It is 100% coursework so the key to success is meeting deadlines.
2. **Examples** – to achieve level 2 students must use examples to help explain and expand on their answers.
3. **Research** – Students need to research into finding the necessary answers for their various units.
4. **Recording** – for several units they need to carry out various tasks for the Businesses they are running and therefore they need to keep a record of any research and tasks they have personally completed.
5. **Team work** – For units 14 & 15 (Enterprise) they need to work well with others and ensure they all complete the tasks allocated. Make sure that each team member has the same facts and figures when writing up their assignments

6. **Presentations** – When doing presentations to the class make sure that everything is explained with examples. Include facts and figures.
7. **Framework** – Each handbook has a box for each question and this indicates the amount of work the exam board is expecting for that particular answer.
8. **Pace** –each student has the opportunity to work through at their own pace and therefore they should be able to receive one to one help as the course progresses –always ask for help if unsure.
9. **Nationwide website** – Use the fact sheets to help you and write it up in your own words.
