Today, we hosted the Cambridgeshire Immunisation team on site to deliver the Covid-19 Vaccination Programme for young people. The students behaved excellently and were all wearing short sleeved tops, so the process ran very efficiently. Thank you to the parents and carers for your support with ensuring that your children were wearing the correct attire today. Despite this, we are very disappointed that the nurses, who worked tirelessly throughout the day, were unable to vaccinate all the students for whom parental consent had been received. This was due to the fact that there were fewer nurses on site today than we had been told to expect.

As a consequence, the school has been informed that there will be a **'catch-up' session on Wednesday 13 October**. More information about the arrangements will be sent nearer the date. We have also been asked to send out to you a **letter of apology from the Cambridgeshire Immunisation Team** (see attached).
