RE: LAMDA Speech and Drama Exams

We are delighted to announce that we offer students the chance to take a LAMDA qualification in Speech and Drama, and have some extra spaces from September.

LAMDA is a world-leading Drama school and examinations provider and its exams are recognised across the world so we are extremely fortunate to be able to offer these sessions to our students.

Exams are not just open to students who are interested in Drama but are available for any student who would like to improve their confidence and public speaking.

Just some of the many skills that students gain from taking these classes include:

- Clearer and more confident speech
- Improved posture
- Improved reading comprehension
- Concentration and memory skills
- Increasing vocabulary and awareness of classical literature
- Independent study skills


An external provider hosts the sessions within school hours, with 1:1 weekly sessions charged at £16 for 30 minutes. There will also be a small charge for students to take their exam. Courses should be paid for in advance, on a termly basis, and students will be expected to make up any classwork that they miss in their own time.

If any student would like to attend the LAMDA exams but is falling into financial hardship, please speak to Mrs Alexander, Head of Drama, and the school will look at each application on a case-by-case basis. Her email address is: EAlexander@hbk.acesmat.uk.

Sessions will include:

- 1:1 Acting
- Verse and Prose
- Public Speaking
- Devising Drama
- Mime

Students will work with the teacher to choose the discipline that suits them best, taking exams graded between 1 and 8, with the higher-grade students gaining UCAS points to help with University applications. LAMDA lessons and exam preparation time can also be counted towards the skills section of the Duke of Edinburgh award.





Mrs Burgess, the LAMDA Speech and Drama Teacher taking the classes, is a First Class graduate in Drama and holds an FdA in Professional Acting. She says her passion is to help students become articulate speakers and to perform with confidence. To date, her student pass rate is 100%, with all of her students awarded either a Merit or Distinction in their exam.
