



- * Parental satisfaction with how Hinchingbrooke has managed lockdown has significantly increased from Spring 2020 (Very happy has more than doubled to 52% and positive responses are up by 22% to 93%) Positive feedback on the school's communication has increased from 73% to 93% and parents are 26% happier with the provision of work, with those who give this the top rating more than doubling to 50%
- * Student feedback is broadly consistent across all year groups, with only very small numbers giving negative responses to any of the survey questions. Indeed, the highest number of negative responses were to the question about how well students themselves were working
- * Staff responses show that 94% are happy with the way that the school has managed this lockdown, with 95% expressing a positive view of the way communication has been handled and 89% reporting that expectations were clear. However, 51% of staff reported that their workload had increased as a result of the current lockdown.


