Screening of Year 9 students for possible exam access arrangements – message from Mr Jones, Assistant Principal SEND

Next half term the Exams team will be screening all year 9 students to ascertain whether any access arrangements are required for GCSE exams. This will involve students completing an online screening activity during the school day. Following the screening, we will be in touch if any further action is indicated for your child.

ARBOR email issues – message from Mr Pinder, Vice-Principal

We have been experiencing some issues with our Arbor Management Information System and the accurate delivery and receipt of emails to some families. We ask that parents/carers check their 'junk/trash folders' for any missed emails and add '**Arbor**' to the safe sender's list.

There have also been a small number of incidents where emails sent from Arbor have not been sent at all – we apologise for that and would like to reassure you that every effort is being made by the Trust to resolve this issue with Arbor as soon as possible.
