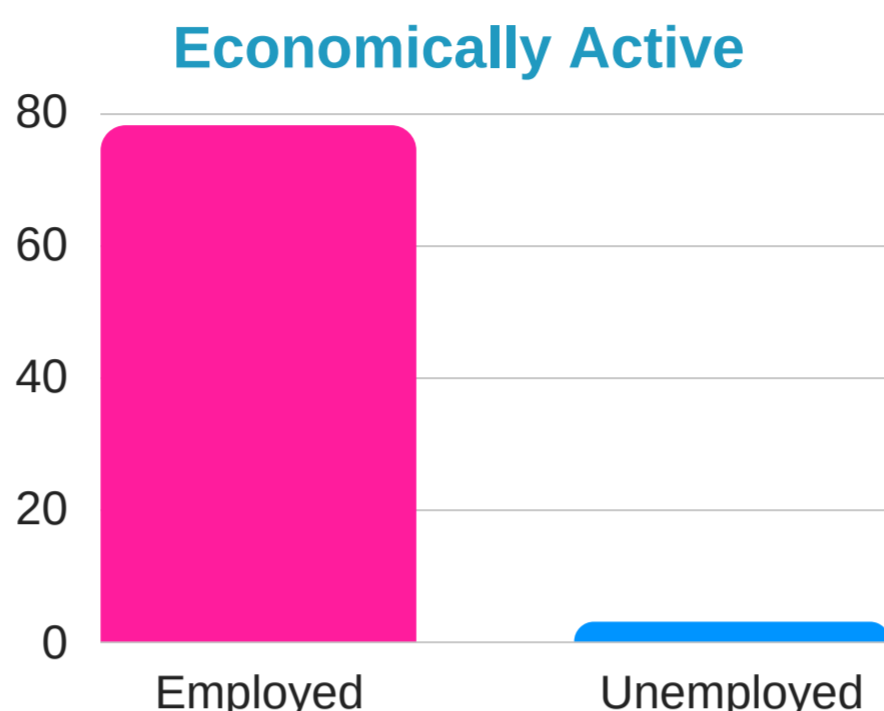


East of England

Unemployment

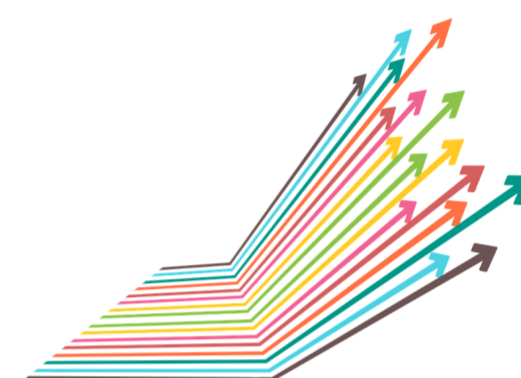
3% of people in the East of England are unemployed. **Lower** than the UK average of **4.1%**.



The average income is **£30,695** a year

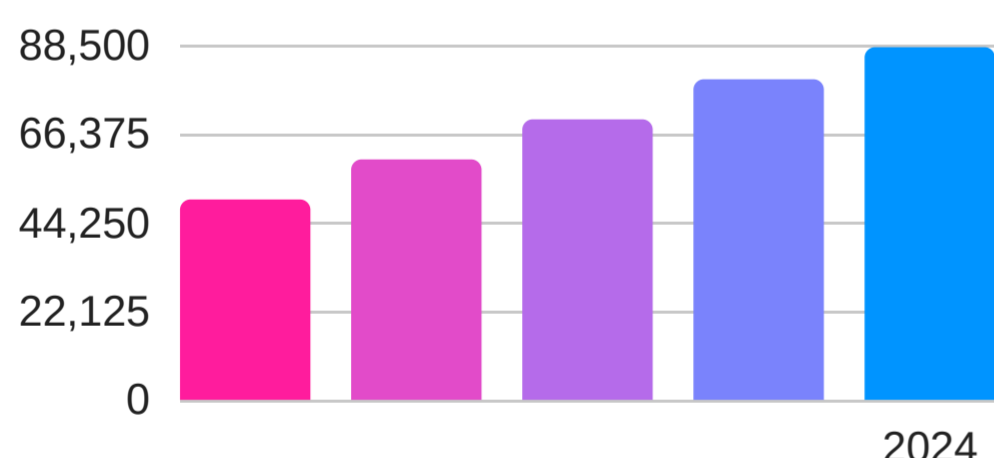


On average people in the East of England work **32.2** hours a week
