


Supporting your child in language learning

Language Acquisition



- Passive, then active.
 - Important to learn vocabulary from FL into English and vice-versa.
 - Always easier translating into own language.
- Notice patterns and Mimic
 - Grammar rules need to be drilled.
 - Repetition, repetition, repetition!
 - A little but often cramming does not work in MFL!

Vocabulary Learning Techniques

- Start from TL into English.
- Techniques:
 - Look, cover, reproduce, check
 - Flashcards
 - Word- / picture-association (hérisson / gracias)
 - Speak out loud
 - Spelling Bee
 - Web-sites
 - Songs
- A little but often 10 minutes at a time
