We are proud to announce that in just 16 days we have produced and donated **over 2,400 reusable visors** to Hinchingsbrooke Hospital, Cambridge & Peterborough NHS Foundation Trust and their community teams, Papworth Hospital, Northampton General Hospital, local care homes, doctors surgeries, pharmacies, hospices, prisons as well as local community groups working with the homeless and other medical settings.

None of this would have been achievable without the generous donations of school staff and its House Teams – as well as the competitive prices offered by our local supplier, Charpak.



There is still a need for visors in our community and our team of 40 staff volunteers are willing to continue as long as the need is out there
