Plans for September

School Lockers

Because of Lockdown, many students will not have had the opportunity to clear their lockers (assuming they need clearing). Starting next week we can give them the opportunity to empty their locker as follows:

Mondays – Year 7

Tuesdays – Year 8

Wednesdays – Year 9

Thursdays – Year 13

Students should aim to access school between 10am and 2pm on their allocated day. Students in Years 10 and 12 should aim to clear their lockers on a day where they are already in school.

If your child cannot come in on their allocated day before the end of term, please ring the school and we will arrange for them to come in at another time.
