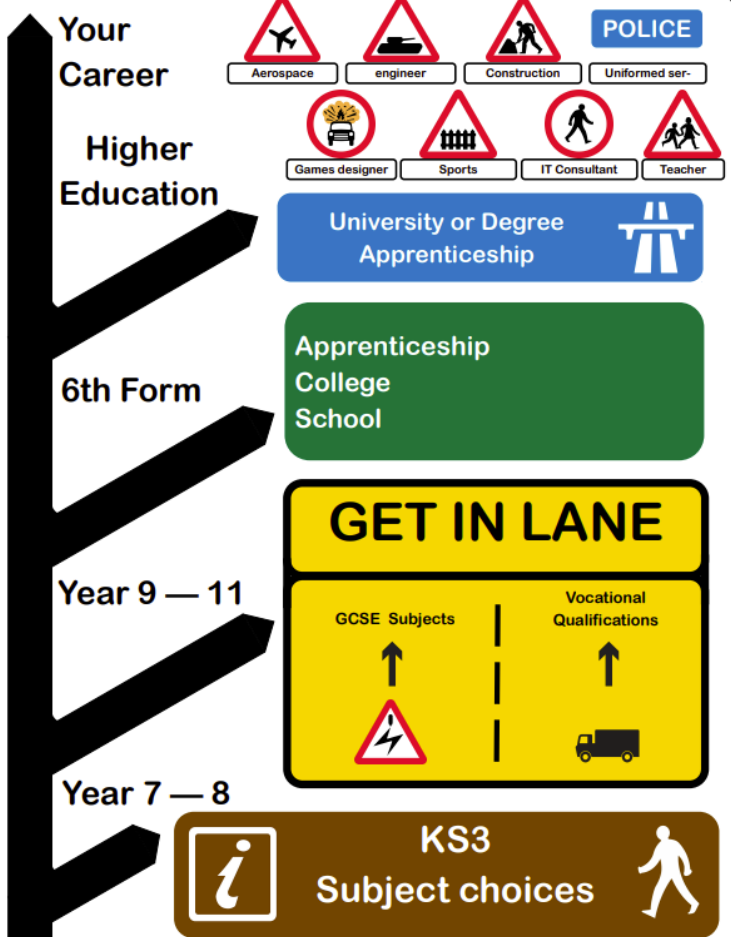


Pathways – Apprenticeships

Pathways



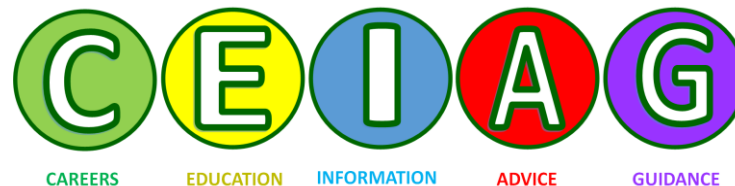
There are four different levels of apprenticeships

Intermediate - equivalent to 5 GCSEs grades 4+. The qualification achieved is Level 2 NVQ, Diploma, National certificate

Advanced - Equivalent to 2 A levels. The qualification achieved is level 3 NVQ, Diploma, National certificate

Higher - Equivalent to a foundation degree or higher. The qualification achieved is foundation degree, bachelor's degree, master's degree, level 4 – 7 NVQ, Higher national diploma

Degree - Equivalent to a bachelors/master's degree. The qualification achieved is foundation degree, bachelor's degree, master's degree, level 4 – 7 NVQ, Higher national diploma
