Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am writing to provide some further information about our upcoming Open Evening on Thursday 13th October from 5 pm – 7 pm. We are very keen for both yourselves and your child to attend this event, as there will be a number of interactive displays by departments. In addition, this is an opportunity for students in Year 6 to meet not only many of our staff but a number of the students as well, as they will be supporting the departments around the school site.

The evening consists of two components: a tour of the school and a talk in the Performing Arts Centre (PAC) by the Principal, Head Students, and the Head of Year 7. Once you arrive at school, please make your way to the Food Court (the pink-roofed building) where there will be senior students around to help direct you.

In order to cater for the large numbers that we are anticipating, please choose one of the following options:

Option A: Tour first and talk second

5 pm at the Food Court to collect your Welcome Tour Guide and commence your tour until 6pm.

Then a talk in the PAC (Performing Arts Centre) at 6.15 pm by the Principal, Head Students, and the Head of Year 7.

or

Option B: Talk first and tour second

5 pm at the Food Court and then make your way to the PAC (Performing Arts Centre) for a talk at 5.15 pm by the Principal, Head Students, and the Head of Year 7. Then to the Food Court at 5.45 pm to collect your Welcome Tour Guide and commence your tour.

If you prefer to make your way around the site independently then you are free to do so. As part of your tour, you will be able to meet many of the staff and students. Mrs Pittock – Student Support Officer for Year 7 and Year 7 Form Reps will be ready to discuss the Transition process and to answer any questions you might have, along with Mr Wheeley – The Assistant Head of Year 7.

As parking is limited on site, we strongly recommend that you either walk or car-pool in order to reduce traffic. Some of our sixth form students will be on site to assist with parking within the school grounds.
