

### Target Grades for KS5

This is what your child should aspire to achieve at the end of Year 13. We generate this grade by using a range of data including pupils' GCSE grades and national benchmarks for similar students studying the same qualifications. These targets are reviewed annually in the light of progress made during the previous year. Whilst these grades are aspirational, your child should not see them as a ceiling and should work consistently well over their time in Sixth Form. If this is the case, they may well achieve higher than their target grade.

Grades are based on the A\*-U grading system, where an A\* is the top grade available. For BTEC qualifications, the grading uses; Pass (P), Merit (M), Distinction (D) and Distinction(D)\*.
