- Children who are entitled to Free School Meals;
- Children who were entitled to Free School Meals within the last 6 years;
- Children who are in care;
- Children who were in care and are now adopted;
- Families who lost a parent who served in the Armed Forces;
- Families where at least one parent serves in the Armed Forces (Services) within the last six years.

# How is Pupil Premium Spent at Hinchingsbrooke?



- Some of the money goes towards our Bridge provision in Years 7 and 8;
- Some of the money goes towards the Gateway Provision for students unable to cope in mainstream and need an alternative;
- Running a school breakfast club to improve attendance and ensure students are ready to learn;
- Part funding the school counsellor;
- Investing in resources that boost children's learning, such as laptops;
- Providing a fully stocked pencil case to all Year 6 into 7 students during transition;
  
- Vouchers to support families so they are able to buy ingredients for cooking lessons;
- Running a range of programs for targeted students in all year groups such Small Steps, Scholars Edge and Boxing Futures;
- Purchasing reading books for the Guided Reading program and funding competitions;
- Funding prizes for attendance, reading, achievement and engagement;
- The Year 9 Scholar's Program which involves trips to universities;
- Curriculum essential trips and visits;
- Tutoring in Maths, English and Sciences for Year 11 students.
