

### Current Grade

This is the grade your child is currently working at in each subject.

Grades are based on the A\*-U grading system, where an A\* is the top grade available. Each grade is split into three fine grades to give you more detail. A '+' is at the top of the grade and close to attaining the grade above and '-' denotes being insecure within a grade. A grade without a '+' or '-' is a secure grade in the middle of that grade.

For BTEC qualifications, the grading uses: Ungraded (U), Near Pass (N), Pass (P), Merit (M), Distinction (D) and Distinction(D)\*. We use the fine grading system with BTEC grades, so the lowest grade is a Pass- and the maximum is a Distinction\*+.

### Predicted Grade

The predicted grade is the grade that we believe your child will get in their A-Level exams if they continue to work as they have been working. The grade includes consideration of all the important work that students do, such as assessments and coursework.
