Residential Trip to Caythorpe Court 29th June - 1st July

The year 7 residential is fast approaching so I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the final arrangements for the weekend.

Students should arrive at school for their normal registration with form tutors and should be dressed in the clothing that they will be travelling to Caythorpe in. Please can students bring their kit items in a single bag that is clearly labelled (sleeping bags/duvets/pillows may be separate). Please also ensure all individual items are named.

Students will be working in their form groups with their form tutors, as well as in their activity groups during the morning and will board the coaches at 1.45pm. We will be returning to the school bus bays for 7.45 pm on Sunday 1st July. In order to avoid traffic jams when the coaches return please do not park in the bus bays. You can park your cars in the car park nearest Hinchingbrooke House.

- 1 pair of shoes for water sports
- 1 pair of trainers for activities
- Fleeces/sweatshirts for activities
- T shirts
- Waterproof jacket
- Sun hat
- Sun sun screen
- 1 or 2 sets of clothes for the evening

- 1 towel for showering
- One "old" towel for water based activitities
- Plastic drinks bottle
- Small ruck sack
- Labelled bin bag for dirty clothing
- Wash bag
- Sleeping bag/duvet and pillow
