University of Cambridge presents:

'The Subject Matters' Year 11 A Level Advice Sessions

A significant number of students fail to gain places at top universities because when they were choosing their A level subjects they either did not have access to the relevant advice or they failed to realise the future implications of their choices.

When assessing applicants at the University of Cambridge, they consider not only the individual A Level (or equivalent) subjects taken but also the combination of subjects. They say "we generally prefer applicants to have taken certain subjects, or combinations of subjects, because they are more likely to provide an effective preparation for study at the University".

To address this issue the University of Cambridge will be running a practical and informative Saturday afternoon session called the: 'The Subject Matters' focusing on the importance of suitable A Level (or equivalent) subject choices in support of an application to a top research led university.

The sessions led by The University of Cambridge will aid students in this important decision making process and help them access the information they need to make informed A Level choices.

The dates of the advice sessions are: Saturday 5th October, repeated on Saturday the 19th October and also on Saturday the 23rd November. The sessions run from 1.30pm until 4.30pm with registration from 12.45pm.
