## 2014 Lower School German Exchange Hinchingbrooke (Huntingdon) - Andreae Gymnasium (Herrenberg)

Dear Parent/Carer,

For many years Hinchingbrooke School has run a successful exchange link with its partner school in Germany. The Andreae Gymnasium is located in the beautiful old town of Herrenberg, close to the city of Stuttgart and the Black Forest. I expect the dates of the Lower School German Exchange to be as follows:

Herrenberg visitors in Huntingdon from 15<sup>th</sup> May to 22<sup>rd</sup> May 2014 Hinchingbrooke leaving in the evening of 11<sup>th</sup> July and arriving back on the morning 20<sup>th</sup> July 2014

I would like to encourage your son/daughter to participate in this highly successful, well-established exchange which has been running for 24 years. We make every effort to match our pupils according to age and interest and over the years many long-term friendships have been established between pupils and families in the two countries.

This exchange is open to students studying German in Years 7 and 8 only. Experience has shown that students benefit socially and academically from living with their host family for a week.

An exchange visit gives all pupils preparing for their Key Stage 3 German assessments the opportunity to hear, practice and extend the language they have acquired in the classroom, whilst also learning something of the country and the lifestyle of young Germans and their families.

When we are in Germany our pupils attend some lessons with their German partners and visit a number of places of interest in Southern Germany. In recent years we have visited the Wilhelma animal park, Burg Hohenzollern and Badkap swimming complex. Additionally, the host families often organise excellent excursions for after school and weekends.

When the German students visit us, we organise a similar programme and they attend some lessons at Hinchingbrooke with their partners. Additionally, we organize some excursions for them such as a trip to Woburn, punting and a treasure hunt in Cambridge.

Government legislation on charging for School Activities, under the terms of the Education Act 1988, means that this visit which is predominantly in school time cannot be charged for compulsorily. A voluntary contribution is therefore requested of £290.00 per student, in order to cover the cost of transport, entrances, insurance, staffing etc. This amount is approximate and will depend on the exchange rate, changes in entrance charges and fuel prices and, most importantly, the number of participants. It may be possible to reduce the cost if we have sufficient students taking part. The school reserves the right to cancel this activity if there are insufficient funds available.

We propose that payments should be made in five stages: the first payment of £70 deposit (non-refundable) as a sign of firm intent and the remaining four payments spread across January - April 2014. Details of payments will be issued once the numbers of participants are finalised. If you wish your son/daughter to be involved in this exchange, please return the attached slip as soon as possible, but **no later than Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2013**, together with a deposit payment of £70 to the Finance Cashier in the OMD (Old Middle School Dining Room) at any break time or before school. Cheques should be made payable to 'Hinchingbrooke School' and marked on the reverse with, 'Lower School German Exchange' as well as the student's name and form. Please note that credit/debit cards are also accepted and payment can be made by calling the Accounts Dept on 01480-420502. **Payments must not be handed to form tutors or German teachers**. Please also provide a copy of the photo page of your child's passport.

Please note that students will require their own passport as well as a European Medical Card which can be obtained by applying online at <a href="www.ehic.org.uk">www.ehic.org.uk</a>. Places are allocated on a first come, first served basis. Names will also be placed on a reserve list. Receipt of a deposit does not guarantee a place, which is dependent on the ability to match your child with a suitable partner as well as them having acceptable standards of behaviour in school. Deposits are returnable in the event of students not being allocated a place. The attached form must also be filled in <a href="BY AN ADULT">BY AN ADULT</a> in capital letters, giving FULL names and returned complete with a passport photo attached to the form along with the deposit.
